## PRODUCTION

---

Winemakers, Santiago Mayorga, has access to some of the best vineyard sites in Mendoza. The focus is on small productions of high quality wines. Gualtallary is a charming micro region located in the Tupungato Appellation of Uco Valley, Mendoza. Located at an altitude of 1300masl (which gives intense cold night temperatures), the terroir is outstanding with limestone, sandy and rocky soils. 60% of the wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels of 1st, 2nd and 3rd use.

## TASTING NOTE

---

The combination of altitude (1300m) and rocky soils provide a platform for Malbec to excel. Pure, opaque ox-blood in colour, the nose carries notes of morello cherry, black tea and spice. The palate is elegant with lovely weight, dense dark cherry and raisined chocolate fruit yet with fresh acidity. The finish is firm with classically granitic Tupungato character.

## FOOD MATCH

---

Roasted lamb, red meats, and the perfect match to the traditional "empanadas" from Argentina (home made meat pies). Or perfect as a comforting, fireside wine.
